Your Executive Committee takes pleasure in presenting Annual Report for the year ending 31st March 2022 along with Audited Annual Accounts for the year ended on that date. During the year under review, the following are our achievements.

### ACTIVITIES & PROGRAMMES

#### **ANIMAL WELFARE PROGRAMME**

One of our prioritized activities is Animal Welfare Activity. In this year under this activity our Organization got 120 stray dogs sterilized and vaccinated across the district to prevent rabbis. We have organized awareness programs for people in forest areas about benefits of wildlife.



Conservation of forests is our other activity under this intervention. We have sensitized the community through media campaigns and posters on wild life and social forestry in both urban and rural areas of GAYA district.

#### **PLANTATION PROGRAMME**

BUDDHA VIKLANG VIKAS SANSTHAN is one of the best NGOs in Bihar, India. Which plays a role as a dedicated environment leader found a new dimension with the





launching of the billion tree campaign and initiative for popularizing solar Technology among the urbanites of Bihar. The uniqueness is again in the massive participation of the community at the grass-root levels.

BUDDHA VIKLANG VIKAS SANSTHAN Anti plastic campaign is a unique campaign against pollution-free slums in Gaya District of Bihar State. We regularly spread awareness generation programs, rallies, other public events, painting competitions, etc are organized in the operational areas, which are marked by creative community participation and involvement. #### **RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME**

The Secretary of the society begins with the key issue of people's participation in development process. Society believes that the process of participation, which forms the crux of sustainable development process, needs to be understood and applied in specific context for becoming effective and viable in its true sense.



Participation by the community in the water management is a key to development. Society motivated the farmers and educated them on the critical importance of the water harvesting structures in their villages and used their field for community use. People's participation involves, building on their skills, collective enthusiasm, values and wisdom. With people's participation, scope of development interventions can be expanded, operations strengthened and the impact enriched. However, in each case the concepts applicable to given contexts commensurate with abilities of participants.



## CORONA AWARENESS PROGRAMME

A Non-Governmental Organisation (NGO) BUDDHA VIKLANG VIKAS SANSTHAN organised a special awareness programme on surgical care during the COVID-19 pandemic in the various districts of Bihar and Jharkhand State. A number of doctors and health experts participated in the programme. Though the government health sector has improved in the last



few years, some reputed Non-Government Organisations (NGOs) are playing great roles in helping people during the pandemic.

These organisations have the latest types of machinery and medical equipment including high-tech ambulances, oxygen concentrators, wheelchairs, and stretchers.

Buddha Viklang Vikas Sansthan an NGO running projects on water conservation and women's development in different districts of Bihar and Jharkhand state of carried out an awareness drive among the rural populace on Covid-19 management. Women used methods like rangoli and poster making to spread awareness in the villages.

## MASK DISTRIBUTION AND RATION DISTRIBUTION TO POOR

Our Ngo Buddha Viklang Vikas Sansthan has contributed a lot while working for coronavirus relief; the glimpse of the same is as follows:

- While working for coronavirus relief, our NGO has distributed more than Ten thousand face masks to survive the black swan period of COVID-19.





- While working for coronavirus relief, we have installed 212 foot-operated sanitizer dispensers and automatic sanitizer dispensers. We plan to install sanitizer dispensers at temples and other religious places to efficiently and safely manage the gatherings.
- We have also donated many face masks, ration pouches, and other relief related materials to needy workers going through this time during the pandemic. By observing the current market situation in which a section of impoverished people has become unemployed.

### VOCATIONAL TRAINING

Our organisation is providing the vocational training programme under district literacy committee in Patna and other districts of Bihar State. Vocational Training/Education has many advantages. It helps a person choose his career early in life and formally trained



persons. we shall be able to produce more and more sources to make the nation strong and prosperous. Vocational training is used to prepare students for a certain trade or craft. The programs prepare students to be ready for specific careers.

### CULTURAL PROGRAMME

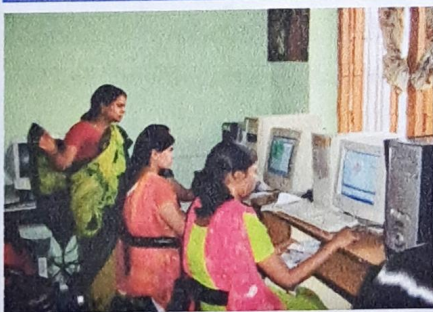


will ensure that they can get an equal opportunity in every field viz. issues of education, employment, welfare, community living, justice and other aspects of daily living.

#### VOCATIONAL PROGRAMME



Our organization organized continues Skill Development Mission programme in different villages/panchayats & Schools of Patna and Other districts of BIHAR State. To start with, Skill Development Team conducts student mobilization activities in schools and colleges through presentations & posters and in villages & local communities through mobilization vans, pamphlet distribution, community meetings, etc. The team further works with Village Pradhan, frontline workers to mobilize prospective students. Minimum qualification required for undertaking these courses is higher secondary.



Once selected, students are trained in batches of 30 and course duration varies from 3 months to 1 year with on the job training. Post training, students are assessed by concerned Sector Skill Council. Our Society facilitates placements for successfully assessed students at public and private health facilities.

### **WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME**

Gender equality remains a burning issue even when women play equally important roles in driving the rural economy in India. Women have always been facing the inequitable distribution of domestic chores besides other



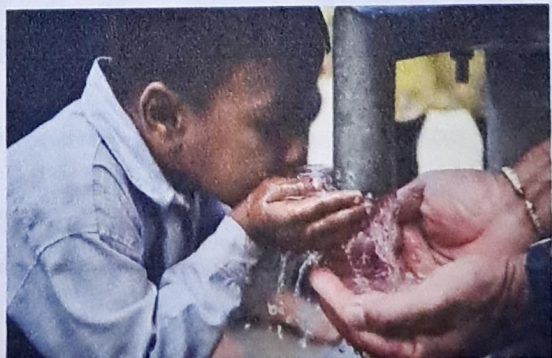
responsibilities such as fetching water, collecting firewood and even working in the farms. This is severely impacting their physical security, opportunities for adult education, overall productivity, income generation capacity, nutritional status, and overall health and well-being.

BUDDHA VIKLANG VIKAS SANSTHAN is driving initiatives to reduce the 'time poverty' and drudgery of women, provide them with access to economic opportunities and enable their participation in decision-making, so that they become equal partners in the development process.

### **WATER AND SANITATION PROGRAMME**

We work with government and partners to ensure that every child in India has access to clean water, basic toilets and practices good hygiene behaviors.

Our organization organized continue





sanitation programme in different villages of Gaya District of Bihar State with the Norms of District Water & Sanitation Committee (PHED). Sanitation is most for health and hygiene. We should attention on Sanitation, because of it we cannot live healthy, it is universal truth that sound mind in a sound body hence, our first and foremost priority should be sanitation. Our organization has decided to employment sanitation programme in all villages of Panchayat. This practice amounted to tonnes of faeces introduced *daily* into the environment, which regularly exposed India's children to excrement through direct contact. The risk of spreading diarrheal and waterborne diseases is compounded by the lack of regular handwashing and microbial contamination of water in their homes and communities. The situation contributed to nearly 100,000 diarrhoeal deaths of children under five years in India.

#### **S.C., S.T., WELFARE PROGRAMME**

Despite of passing of so many years after independence Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Minorities have yet been associated in the main stream of the Society. They still need a lot of support a not only from the Government but also from the society and NGO's.



Understanding its responsibility the Society has organized a number of programmes targeted at the welfare of the SC/ST. This includes imparting Non-formal Education in the areas of SC/ST, providing them technical and Financial help in setting up their own business and pursuing higher studies.
