### ACTIVITIES & PROGRAMMES

#### **ANIMAL WELFARE PROGRAMME**

Buddha Viklang Vikas Sansthan working for animal welfare tend to the ill and injured animals. They also conduct a lot of drives and projects for neutering, vaccinating the animals, providing them with other health facilities, and conducting adoption drives.



We have sensitized the community through media campaigns and posters on wild life and social forestry in both urban and rural areas of GAYA district. Our society also actively spread awareness about

the importance of animal welfare to the public and conduct charity events and fundraisers to finance their expenses.



### **PLANTATION PROGRAMME**

Society is a leading environmental NGO in Bihar and a dedicated green yatra (green journey) towards protection, conservation and betterment of Mother Nature and Humanity. Our sole objective is to create a greener and better world for present and future generations. We are working on our various projects to nullify the environmental imbalance caused by us and our society at large. Our organization successfully planted trees of various varieties such as Pipal, Neem and Amrapali, Maldah, Bombay, Kalkatia, in fruits Jammun, Banana, licchi, Kathal and many more varieties of public utility trees. Since the inception of the BUDDHA VIKLANG VIKAS SANSTHAN, we have planted thousands of trees in different states across pan India and we



work towards implementing various programs on social forestry, and community forestry. We also aim to raise nurseries of various plants and to conduct various environmental awareness programs.

### **RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME**

The Secretary of the society begins with the key issue of people's participation in development process. Society believes that the process of participation, which forms the crux of sustainable development process, needs to be understood and applied in specific context for becoming effective and viable in its true sense.

Participation by the community in the water management is a key to development. Society motivated the farmers and educated them on the



critical importance of the water harvesting structures in their villages and used their field for community use. People's participation involves, building on their skills, collective enthusiasm, values and wisdom.

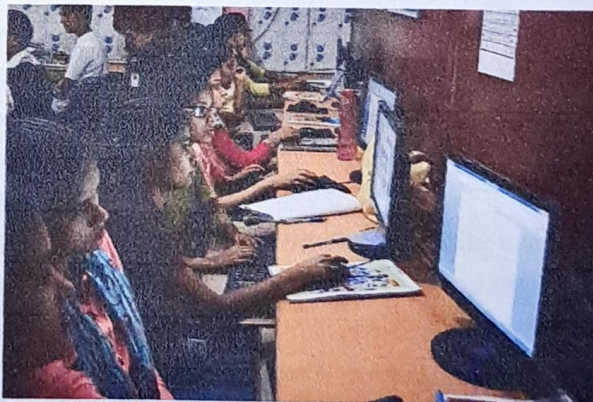
With people's participation, scope of



development interventions can be expanded, operations strengthened and the impact enriched. However, in each case the concepts applicable to given contexts commensurate with abilities of participants.

#### VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME

We organize vocational training for underprivileged, adolescent girls, low-literate youth. Culturally, many of these girls are likely to be married at a rather young age. These vocational skills like the computer, sewing, cutting & tailoring, beauty treatments and basic IT skills allow these girls to pursue financial independence and help in their skill development. For this, we are constantly trying



to set up Vocational centers with skilled trainers that can understand their needs and give training as per their adaptability. The aim of this project is



to impart education and skill development in children, youth and women so that they can live a life of dignity and respect.

Financial independence is crucial for breaking the cycle of poverty.

- Most of these skills are neither seasonal nor topical.
- Significant improvement in the chances of employment.
- Make them earn a dependable livelihood for their family needs.

#### LITERACY PROGRAMME

Our society organized literacy programme for poor children in Gaya and other districts of Bihar State. Our NGO working for poor child education which is dedicatedly working on rendering facilities such as basic education and healthcare to needy and helpless children residing amid the walls



of poverty. Literacy and Education essentially is the basic ingredients for development. Economic development is closely associated with poverty reduction. Human development is the end-economic growth. Literacy and education have a direct role in human development and are instrumental in facilitating other achievements.

The significant effects of primary education on reduction in poverty and improvement in income distribution, improvement in health and nutritional status of the population growth, and positive association with adoption of family planning methods and its positive relationship with general social, political and economic development and overall quality of life are well recognised.

Women have to be integrated in the mainstream society as by and large in India they do not enjoy equal status with men and still have to



fight their way through if they want to achieve social or economic advancement. For these causes your society working for the education for all men, women, girls and boys children. Society wants to sure primary education for them. Under the direction of society education centre runs in the villages of Gaya Districts of Bihar State.

### WATER AND SANITATION PROGRAMME

We work with government and partners to ensure that every child in India has access to clean water, basic toilets and practices good hygiene behaviors.

Our organization organized continue sanitation programme in different villages of Gaya District of Bihar State with the Norms of District Water & Sanitation Committee (PHED). Sanitation is most for health and hygiene. We should attention on Sanitation, because of it we cannot live healthy, it is universal truth that sound mind in a sound body hence, our first and foremost priority should be



sanitation. Our organization has decided to employment sanitation programme in all villages of Panchayat. This practice amounted to tonnes of faeces introduced *daily* into the environment, which regularly exposed India's children to excrement through direct contact. The risk of spreading diarrheal and waterborne diseases is compounded by the lack of regular handwashing and microbial contamination of water in their homes and communities.



### WELFARE PROGRAMME (S.C., S.T.)

Our society organized literacy programme for poor children in Gaya and other districts of Bihar State. Despite of passing of so many years after independence

Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Minorities have yet been associated in the main stream of the Society. They still need a lot of support a not only from the Government but also from the society and NGO's.



Understanding its responsibility the Society

has organized a number of programmes targeted at the welfare of the SC/ST. This includes imparting Non-formal Education in the areas of SC/ST, providing them technical and Financial help in setting up their own business and pursuing higher studies.

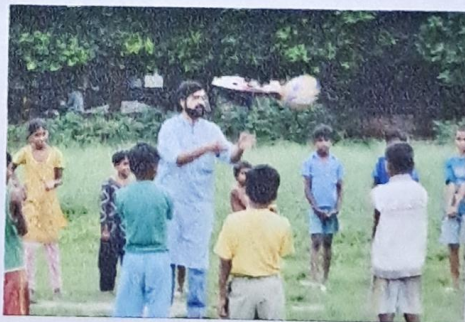
### **BRIDGE COURSE TO BLIND CHILDREN**
